

Market Review

- Returns on U.S. dollar-denominated money market and short-term instruments were mostly unchanged in July.
- Time deposits and other short-term dollar outlets continue to offer steady yields as the U.S. Federal Reserve (Fed) signaled that they were in no rush to cut interest rates, despite pressure from President Trump. The market is expecting the next rate cut from the Fed in September.
- Money market yields are expected to fall from current levels as policymakers may move to support employment.
